
Difference cables are located on the teaching desk.











Turn on the visualizer by pressing the "ON/OFF" button.

Turn on the BLU-RAY player by pressing the "ON/STANDBY" button.






Reset MICROHPONE VOLUME




Change projector picture aspect ratio: 16:9, 4:3 and normal.

Press the SCREEN button.






Use Classroom Microphone as Zoom Microphone for Voice Capture.


Connect UM wire network cable, HDMI cable and USB cable (labeled for Zoom, "Dante USB Receiver") to your notebook.

Make sure your click "Join with Computer Audio" and join your audio to the meeting.






Click on the up arrow and select.

"VM-2HN" as your speaker.




Connect HDMI cable to your notebook.

Turn on the visualizer by pressing the ON/OFF button.




Press the LAMP SWITCH button to change the LED lamp status: bright, dim and off.
